Did you know? The Inland Revenue Department state that Individual and business donors who are chargeable to salaries tax, personal assessment or profits tax can claim deduction for the aggregate of approved charitable donation up to 25% of the assessable income or profits, as the case may be, in the basis period of a year of assessment. Such aggregate must not be less than \$100. (Sections 16D and 26C of the Inland Revenue Ordinance)
